

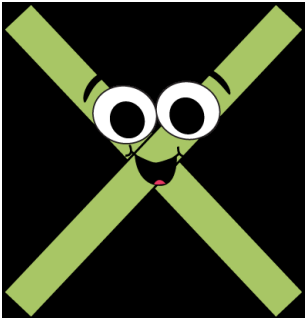

Times Table Champions



How will the challenge work?

-There are 3 levels – Bronze, Silver and Gold

All children started on x2 bronze

-When they get 30/30 on a test, they will move onto the next level.

- Teachers will award a 'Times Table champions certificate' when a child gets 100% and tell your child the next table they will be working on.

How will you know which table your child is on?

-In the back of your child's HASP book, they should have a **Times Table tracking sheet**. Once they have achieved e.g. Bronze x2, they will get a star in that box and their teacher will sign and date it.

Testing

- For the next 2 weeks, teachers will be giving your children Timetables tests most days (revision of lower tables).
- In Maths classes children will have 5 minutes Times Table practise every day. From week 4 of this term, they will then have 1 test per week.
- We will then introduce the challenge across houses and award extra play for all children who have gained 100% in tests.
- 10 house points will be given for 100% on tests. Each term teachers will decide how many house points the children need to get, to gain extra playtime.
- Children will have a tracking sheet displayed in HASP books so you know which Times Table they are on so they can practise at home.

Teaching Times Tables

In class the children will be learning tables in a variety of ways.

These include:

- singing songs
- Recalling them (chanting)
- Using interactive games
- Using apps on I-pads
- Using times table grid at back of HASP book

Homework

Children will still be given Mathletics and sheet homework but it is important to learn your tables.
