Better Behaviours Project

HPF is taking part in a project linked to positive behavior management along with 60 other schools across South Gloucestershire. We have reduced the school rules down to three to make it simpler and easier for children to follow.

They are:

Be ready

Be safe

Be respectful

The children will hear the same language from all staff and this will support consistency for them.

We will share more information as the project develops.

Celebrating Kindness

Each term we focus on a particular behavior or attitude as part of our '30 days to make a change' project. This term we are looking at kindness. As part of this, Year 5 had a visit from a national charity called 52Lives on 22/1. The children learned all about the value of kindness and the emotional and physical benefits of being kind and receiving kindness – the helper's high! They learned about Dylan, a child who is currently unwell and made cards and gifts for him. Greig, who helps run 52Lives, was bowled over by the effort and kindness shown by Year 5. Well done! 52Lives are looking forward to coming back later in the year to work with other year groups!
